Helpful Tips for Planning your Approach to Purchasing Materials for Class

Start with what you need for the first class. It is always a good idea to bring a pencil, pen, eraser and notebook or sketchbook with you. You may already have some materials at home, so you don't need to buy everything new!

In terms of budget, art supplies can vary greatly in quality and price. As young creatives at the beginning of your artistic practice, you do not need to buy high-end, costly materials for your course. Instructors can also offer guidance about materials needed for your course. Look out for an email from your instructor in your ECU email account and reach out to them if you have any questions.

Materials + Software

Studio courses require various materials and/or software for students to work with to experiment with new ideas and create amazing projects.

Materials

Student Material Lists for the Spring Break Art Camps, Junior Arts Institute, and Summer Institute for Teens are made available [prior to the program start](#). Materials differ between studios, and we do our best to consider "must-haves" versus "nice-to-haves." Depending on the course, students can expect materials to cost up to \$180.00. Tuition does not cover the cost of materials.

Software

Information about software required for studios will be made available prior to the start of the program. For courses that require software as part of their curriculum, students will have access to required software in ECU computer labs. To provide students with access to software, ECU will need to use personal information. Consent to use students' personal information must be given in advance; please make sure to review all consent information in the registration application form.
