Helpful tips for planning your approach to buying materials for your course(s)

1. Start with what you need for the first class

- Bring a notebook and pen for taking notes.
- Focus on acquiring the items on your course list that are required for the first day of class. They are marked with an asterisk* on the list.

2. Budget for your supplies

- Art supplies can vary greatly in quality and price. Take some time to understand the pacing of the course and your own learning goals to make informed decisions about what to buy. Instructors will provide more details about the specific materials needed for each course. Talk to them for advice!
- You may already have suitable materials at home; it is not necessary to purchase new materials for every course.

3. Set up any required software

- For courses that require software on the first day of class: purchase, download, and install the required software before the first day of class. This will allow you time to troubleshoot any potential installation issues. Most required software are free or have low-cost educational versions that are available to you as an ECU Continuing Studies student.

<p>35mm Manual Operation Camera*</p> <p>with a built-in light meter and manual controls</p>	<p>Suggested: Pentax K1000, Minolta 101/102, Nikon FM2/FE2, Canon AE1, or contact your instructor for further recommendations.</p> <p>Please ensure that your camera is operational before attending the first class. If it does not come with an Operation Manual, try to source one for your make and model online. If the camera has not been used for a while, we recommend replacing the batteries.</p> <p>Approximate cost for a used manual film camera is \$300</p>
<p>400 ISO black and white film, 36 exposures*</p>	<p>Suggested: Ilford HP5 or Kodak Tmax. 1 roll needed for first class, amount of film used varies per student, with 3-5 rolls being an average estimate.</p> <p>Cost per roll \$15.95</p>
<p>8" x 10" black and white RC photo paper, gloss finish 100 sheets</p>	<p>Suggested: Ilford Multigrade RC Gloss</p> <p>\$160.95</p>
<p>Negative Storage Sleeves, 25/pkg</p>	<p>Suggested: Print File Archival 35-7B</p> <p>\$13.40</p>
